The Sisters Warehouse has enough diaper pens for now. Julie donated 100 diaper pins to them and a hospital donated some to them also.

It was also announced that the Deanery 8 meeting will be April 5th at the Sisters Warehouse. We will need a head count of women going at the next meeting.

Our next meeting will be on March 21st. We need to bring our items for the House of Hope to this meeting and we will bag them up for delivery to the House of Hope.

Caitlin Snow had a request for our help with 2 events coming up.

1. She asked if we would help fill plastic eggs with candy for the Easter Egg hunt which will be on April 8th. We discussed possibly doing it at our March 28th meeting after we fill House of Hope bags. If not at that time, possibly filling them the week after Easter.

2. Confirmation is on April 22nd. She needs us to feed about 45 people at 12:15. It will be the confirmation kids, their sponsors and the clergy. She is having pizza delivered at 11:45 so we will not have to worry about food. We will need to provide drinks and set up and serve. After confirmation around 3:30, there will be a punch and cake reception in the meeting hall for confirmation kids, families, sponsors, and clergy. The cake is being provided but we need to furnish punch and serve and clean up etc. Our usual. We might need 2 different crews.

We can discuss the Confirmation event at the next meeting but we will need to decide about the Easter Eggs before the next meeting so we can be prepared to do them that night if we decide to do it then.
